



Application for Research Time

The MR scanners at the Seaman Family Centre are operated on a cost-recovery basis. Investigators wishing to use the scanner are required to submit their proposal to our Scientific Review Committee. If a letter of support from the Centre is required, the application for time must be submitted *prior to submitting the funding application*.

Currently typical experiments are billed at \$550 per 45-minute imaging session. This charge includes patient preparation and scanning by a licensed MR technologist. Longer studies may incur additional charges. Additional experimental requirements or resources, such as MR contrast agents, will be charged separately. Physics consultation and image processing/analysis will be assessed on a case-by-case basis and may result in an additional charge.
